Petros Dellaportas is a Professor of Statistical Science at the University College London, Professor of Statistics at the Athens University of Economics and Business and Turing Fellow at the Alan Turing Institute, the national institute for data science in UK. His research interests are in the area of computational statistics and machine learning.

He has published many papers in journals of statistics and econometrics such as Annals of Statistics, Biometrika, Journal of the Royal Statistical Society series B, Statistical Science, Journal of Econometrics, Journal of Business and Economics Statistics. He has recently been working in Machine learning methodology and two of his papers have been accepted in the coming NeurIPS 2019 conference. He has co-edited the book “Bayesian Theory and Applications” and he is currently co-editor of Bayesian Analysis journal. He has served as associate editor of few statistical journals including Biometrika and Electronic journal of Statistics.
